The Bakken Museum, a museum of electricity located in Minneapolis, is interested in bringing hands-on science activities to your Girl Scout event or encampment!

Engaging, age-appropriate activities are available for Girl Scout Brownies and Girl Scout Juniors and include fun topics such as electric circuits, magnetism and creative problem solving. Projects can also be adapted to fit your event theme. Each activity session lasts approximately 45 minutes and can accommodate up to 25 girls at one time. Activity sessions can be offered back-to-back to serve all Girl Scout Brownies and Girl Scout Juniors at your event. All girls will make something to take home! Minimum fee of \$150 for up to 50 girls, plus \$3.00 for each additional girl. A transportation fee of \$1 per mile will also be charged.
